





## **Colts High School**

Colts High School received an "A" as its final letter grade for school accountability.

This is a one letter grade increase from last year.

#### STUDENT PERFORMANCE

Thirty percent of a school's letter grade is based on student performance on the state assessment.

#### **Mathematics**

**84%** of students passed the assessment.

This rate is above the state average.

This rate is **below** the state goal.

#### English/Language Arts

**91%** of students passed the assessment.

This rate is above the state average.

#### STUDENT IMPROVEMENT

A school's letter grade may increase, decrease, or remain the same based on student improvement.

#### **Mathematics**

**11.8%** - the pass rate increase between the 8th grade ISTEP+ and the 10th grade ECA.

**39.5%** of students who, after not passing the ECA by the end of 10th grade, have passed the exam by graduation.

### **GRADUATION RATE**

Thirty percent of the letter grade is based on on-time graduation.

92% of students graduated within 4 years.

This rate is above the state average.

This rate is above the state goal.

#### **English/Language Arts**

**0.8%** - the pass rate decrease between the 8th grade ISTEP+ and the 10th grade ECA.

**60.5%** of students who, after not passing the ECA by the end of 10th grade, have passed the exam by graduation.

## COLLEGE & CAREER READINESS (CCR)

Ten percent of the letter grade is based on CCR.

44% of students achieved CCR.








### STUDENT PERFORMANCE

Algebra | End-of-Course Assessment (ECA)




English 10 End-of-Course Assessment (ECA)



## STUDENT IMPROVEMENT


#### 8th - 10th Grade

#### 10th - Graduation


% of students who, after not passing the ECA by the end of 10th grade, have passed the exam by graduation.
