Re: Classes Cancelled/Building Closed/eLearning Days

The School Town of Highland will be cancelling classes beginning on Monday, March 16 and running through Friday, April 10, 2020. This schedule is extremely fluid given the unpredictable and unprecedented nature of this worldwide pandemic event.

The days that classes are not in session will be a combination of days in teacher preparation for eLearning days, waiver days granted to public schools and actual eLearning days. This will give teachers the opportunity to use next week to prepare for E-Learning as students return from Spring Break.

- 3/13-End of 3rd 9 weeks today/Grades due Wednesday, March 18, 2020 at 8:00 a.m.
- 3/16-20: Teacher prep for eLearning
- 3/23-27 : Spring Break
- 3/30: Begin 4th nine weeks of classes

- 3/30-4/3 3rd week for elearning Tuesday/Wednesday/Thursday (Tuesday periods 1, 2,3; Wednesday periods 4,5,6,7; Thursday periods 1,2,3. Monday and Friday will be teacher catch up days for grading assignments)
- 4/6-9: 4th week for elearning Tuesday/Wednesday/Thursday (Tuesday periods 4,5,6,7; Wednesday periods 1,2,3; Thursday periods 4,5,6,7. Wednesday will be teacher catch up days for grading assignments)
- Friday 4/10: Good Friday. No classes.
- Monday 4/13: Return to regular classes.

There will be no extracurricular, co curricular, clubs, Student Council activities, interscholastic or sports during the period of time from Monday , March 16, 2020 through Sunday April 12, 2020.
