

Parents, students, and staff,

This is an update on where things currently stand in regards to the situation involving COVID-19. We received word from Governor Holcomb that Indiana schools will be closed through May 1st. This message is going to provide specific information about our expectations for students during this time:

School Town of Highland spring break will begin on Monday March 23rd. No e-Learning assignments will be given the week of March 23rd-March 27th.

e-Learning course work will still begin on Tuesday March 31st with assignments for student classes in periods 1-3. Wednesday April 1st with assignments for student classes in periods 4-7 and Thursday April 2nd with assignments for students classes in periods 1-3.

e-Learning course work will resume on Tuesday April 7th with periods 4th-7, Wednesday April 8th with periods 1-3, and Thursday April 9th periods 4th-7.

This schedule will continue through May 1st with e-Learning assignments being given on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays with alternating days of periods 1-3 and the next day with periods 4-7.

We will still not have class on Good Friday April 10th.

Extracurricular activities will continue to be suspended during this time through May 1st.

We regretfully also have to cancel the A Honor Roll Breakfast that was scheduled for Thursday April 9th.

We will have more information coming regarding state testing among other concerns as we navigate through this situation.

Please continue to follow guidelines from the CDC including maintaining social distance, avoiding groups of 10 or more people and remembering to wash your hands often.
