The highlight of the day was Lucas Guerra taking 3rd place out of 186 runners and breaking the school record for 5K that was set back in 1995. Lucas ran a blisteringly fast time of 15 minutes, 34 seconds. Congrats Lucas! The boys team took 18th place out of 30 teams. The girls team performed very well taking 14th place out of 30 teams. Grace Aurand finished in 17th place overall out of 188 girls. Grace has the 3rd fastest time in Highland High School history with a time of 19 minutes, 25 seconds for 5K. Catheryn Markus holds the 7th fastest time in school history with a time of 20 minutes, 40 seconds. Congrats ladies!
